## CUBBIES

Cubbies Club is geared to usher 3-5 year olds into an exciting world of learning about God, His Son, and His Word. Each week Parents and Cubbies enjoy time at home reading Memory Verses and Bible Lessons and completing activities that help teach the basic truths about God, Jesus, sin and salvation. Cubbies will review the Bear Hug Memory Verse and Bible Lesson in Club the following week.

Each week Cubbies are checked into their classroom with their Leader Guides to prepare for an evening of fun using crafts, songs, games and puppets to reinforce what they have been learning at home. Bible Lessons and reciting memory verses help to further explain Biblical truths in an age-appropriate way. All of these things motivate Cubbies to learn by reaching them in a way that appeals to preschoolers.

It is our goal to make learning God's Word fun and to help Cubbies "Hide God's Word" in their heart. We are honored to partner with you in doing this!



## SPARKS

The Sparks Club is geared for those clubbers in Kindergarten through 2nd grades. Throughout the three years in Sparks, your child will memorize Scripture, complete handbook activities, and receive a chronological overview of the Bible each year.

Each club night will consist of **Discovery, Recall, and Adventure** – game time!

During our **Discovery** time we will be hearing about various stories from the Bible and applying it to their lives as children.

**Recall** time is a chance for your child to recite the verses (sections) that they have worked to memorize during the week (at home). There will also be activities to help make these truths real in their lives!

After completing the Flight 3:16 entrance book, clubbers will have the opportunity to complete 3 other books, one for each year of Sparks Club. They are able to work through the sections at their own pace. Once a book is completed there are options for review or moving on to a new book depending on current grade.

# T & T

T&T (Truth & Training) teaches 3<sup>rd</sup> – 5<sup>th</sup> graders the truth of God's word and His grace and helps them see how to put that into actions in their lives. In our book "Agents of Grace" children will learn about the attributes of God, the importance of Biblical theology and the seven "I Am" statements of Jesus from the Gospel of John. T&T is a fast paced night of fun and discipleship. After checking in at the Check In area to receive sticker, kids can sign themselves in upstairs in Hall A (just outside of the children's wing). Time is limited during club to recite verses – come prepared!! This can be done during drop-off or at the end of the night. Keep an eye for weekly emails for songs to help with verse memory!

During **Discover** kids will be introduced to the new topic and verse for the week. In smaller groups they will **Explore** each passage further with their peers and team leader and spend time in prayer. We will work together section by section through the book. If you join us later in the year just jump in where we are! We will end the night with an **Adventure**: game time!
