



GENERAL INFO:

- Sign your child in at Check in Stations and receive a security sticker for you and your child.
- Sneakers are the best for AWANA. All ages have game time and running shoes are needed.
- All age groups start with an entrance booklet. Once that booklet is completed, your child will receive their vest (Cubbies and Sparks) and their book for the year.
- All age groups work through a book together with the goal of every child completing a book.
- Memory work should be done at home so there is time for all children to recite their verses for the week. There is extra credit available for those motivated learners.
- Check the AWANA calendar each week to see if there is a theme or project.
- Each age group sends out emails regularly.

CUBBIES – 3 to 5 Year Olds

Cubbies are introduced to an exciting world of learning about God, His Son, and His Word. Each week Parents and Cubbies enjoy time at home reading Memory Verses and Bible Lessons and completing activities that help teach the basic truths about God, Jesus, sin, and salvation. Cubbies check into their classroom for an evening of fun using crafts, songs, games, and puppets to reinforce what they have been learning at home. Pick up is in the same room as drop off.

SPARKS – Kindergarten through 2nd Grade
