



This March our Big Deal is, “Step By Step! God Wants Me to Know Him!” God is not unknowable, impersonable, or mysterious. Rather, God has revealed Himself through the Bible and through Jesus.

March 2: I Can Trust in God

Bible Story: God Called Abram (Genesis 12:1-9; 15:1-6; 17:5)

Our Bible story this week is the story of God calling Abram. God gave Abram a lot of promises, and he trusted in God, believing that God would *always* keep His promises. Preschoolers can know God wants them to trust in Him because He is faithful.

March 9: I Can Talk with God

Bible Story: Abraham’s Three Visitors (Genesis 17:5; 18; 21:1-7)

In our Bible story, Abraham (who is also called Abram) talked with three visitors. Through this conversation, he heard amazing things from God and trusted what God told him. Preschoolers can know that, while God doesn’t always talk to us the same way He talked to Abraham, we can pray and talk with God anytime and know that He hears us. Talking with God is one way we get to know Him more.

March 16: I Can Listen to God

Bible Story: Abram and Lot (Genesis 13; 17:5)

This week, preschoolers will learn they can listen to God. Genesis 13 and 17:5 tell the story of Abram (who was later called Abraham) and his nephew, Lot. When the time came for the two men to choose the land where they would live, Abraham listened to God and followed Him. Preschoolers can know that when they listen to God, they can know more about Him.

March 23: I Can Walk with God

Bible Story: Isaac and Rebekah (Genesis 17:5; 24)

In our Bible story, preschoolers will learn that they can walk with God through the Bible story of Isaac and Rebekah in Genesis 17:5 and Genesis 24. When Abraham’s servant was tasked with finding a wife for Abraham’s son, Isaac, the servant prayed. God helped the servant, and through this example, preschoolers can know that walking with God means we can ask God for help and follow what He tells us to do.

March 30: God Rescues You

Bible Story: God’s Greatest Gift (Romans 5–6)

This week is Hooray Day! Preschoolers will learn that God rescues us. Our Bible story from Romans 5–6 will teach preschoolers that we all need to be rescued because of sin, meaning we have chosen to do what we think is best instead of following what God says is best. Preschoolers can know that while our sin breaks our relationship with God, God loves us so much He sent His Son, Jesus, to rescue us and repair our relationship with Him.
