

April 6 - Week 1: I Can Celebrate the Truth

Bible Story: Jesus Entered Jerusalem Matthew 21:1-17; Mark 11:1-19; Luke 19:28-40; John 2:13-24; 12:12-19

This week we will be doing our Palm Sunday lesson, so we will be teaching about the day that Jesus rode into Jerusalem. This is the start of what is traditionally called Holy Week—the week of events leading up to Jesus' crucifixion and resurrection. As Jesus rode into the city of Jerusalem, people celebrated Him as a King by laying down cloaks and waving palm branches. Kids will learn that we can celebrate the truth of who Jesus is and why He came. In celebrating Jesus, they can point others to Him.

April 13 - Week 2: I Can Believe the Truth

Bible Story: Jesus Is Alive

John 20:1-18

This week will be doing our Easter lesson, we are so excited to celebrate Easter and the Easter story with kids this week through our Bible story from John 20:1-18. On the third day after Jesus' death, some of His followers named Mary, Peter, and John discovered that Jesus was alive! They believed the truth that Jesus died and rose again, making the way for sin to be forgiven and people to have a relationship with God. Kids can believe the truth about who Jesus is and why He came. Belief in Jesus sets people apart as they celebrate and follow Him.

April 20 - Week 3 - Easter Sunday: God Rescues You

Bible Story: God's Greatest Gift Romans 5–6

Theme Verse: "The wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord." (Romans 6:23)

This week your children will attend church with you to celebrate Christ's resurrection! We will be providing this additional lesson focusing on the gospel if you wish to do this with them at home. This "Game Changer" lesson will teach kids, "God Rescues You"! Romans 5–6 tells of the incredible reason why Jesus came—to rescue us from sin and brokenness and make the way for us to have a relationship with God. Kids will learn that this is the most important truth we can know and believe because it changes our lives forever!

April 27 - Week 4: I Can Share the Truth

Bible Story: Jesus Gave the Great Commission Matthew 28:16-20; Mark 16:15-18; Luke 24:48-52; Acts 1:4-8

This month we are teaching kids that they are set apart, and this week, we are teaching that they can share the truth about Jesus. Jesus gave His followers a command, which we call the Great Commission. Jesus told them to go into all the world and tell people the truth about who He is and why He came. Jesus works through His followers to help other people know and follow Him. Kids can know they are set apart to share the truth about Jesus too.
