

TRUE—ISH

This an 8-week series in the Apologetics Root focusing on some statements that are commonly believed to be biblical, but aren't. It's important that we don't mishandle the Word of God. If we say, "Well, the Bible says...", then the Bible better say it. We need to know the difference between truth and half-truth.

## 2 Corinthians 1:3–11

Starting off we will be reading about the truth that disciples of Christ depend on God more than themselves.

### Questions to ask in the car or around the table

- What are examples of suffering in your own life or the lives of your friends?
- What are some different ways you can comfort someone else?
- What is one area of your life where God is calling you to trust in him more?

### Proverbs 16:1–4 and Romans 8:26–30

This week, we will be studying and focusing on the truth that we can trust in the sovereignty of God.

### Questions to ask in the car or around the table

- What objections would someone have for God being in control of the world?
- What is something in your life that makes it hard to trust that God is good?
- How can you counsel others who struggle with God's goodness?

## Romans 5:6–11 and Ephesians 2:1–10

We will be studying and focusing on the truth that only God has the power to save.

### Questions to ask in the car or around the table

- How does understanding your own sin change your appreciation of God's grace?
- How are we supposed to respond to God's grace?
- Since God has given us grace, how can you show grace this week to other people who are hard to love?

## Philippians 4:4-7

Since 5<sup>th</sup> graders will be moving to middle school on the last Sunday of June, we will be taking a break from our series this week. Instead the kids will have a special lesson about changes and promotion and worries as we help kids adjust to those starting middle school and our kids starting their final year of elementary school.

## Acts 16:6–10

The last lesson for the month, will be centered around the truth that disciples of Christ believe God knows best.

### Questions to ask in the car or around the table

- How do you normally respond when you don't get your way? How SHOULD you respond?
- What is something in your life that you are tempted to value more than God?
- What are five reasons why you should treasure Jesus more in your life?
