

# May Treehouse K-3 Take Home



## **Week 1 – May 3: Sharing Jesus Is Important**

## **Bible Story: Paul Told About Jesus (Acts 13–21)**

This May, we are teaching kids the Simple Truth, “I Am Here to Share Jesus.” Kids will learn that sharing Jesus is God’s plan and always worth it because He made the way for us to have a relationship with God. This week, our Bible story comes from Acts 13–21 and follows a disciple named Paul. After Paul started following Jesus, he traveled around and shared Jesus with different people in different places.

**Highlight:** Acts 13:47-48

**Reflect:** Which truth and Bible verse would be helpful when you have the opportunity to share Jesus?

**Connect:** Who are people in your life that would benefit from hearing the good news of Jesus?

## **Week 2 – May 10: God Leads Me to Have Faith**

## **Bible Story: Heroes of the Faith (Hebrews 11)**

Today is a special family worship service so our lesson will only be available online since we will not be having small groups in the Treehouse. Today’s lesson will teach kids that God leads us to have faith. Hebrews 11 is often called “The Hall of Faith” and features stories about many faith-filled men and women. While they faced difficulties and challenges, they clung to faith in God—meaning they trusted and believed God. Kids will learn that God also leads *us* to have faith. Because of Jesus, we can trust and believe God and have a forever relationship with Him.

**Highlight:** Hebrews 11:1-3

**Reflect:** What step of faith is God currently calling you to take?

**Connect:** How has God worked through a special person in your life to help you grow in your relationship with Him?

## **Week 3 – May 17: Sharing Jesus Is God’s Plan**

## **Bible Story: The Emmaus Disciples (Mark 16:12-13; Luke 24:13-49)**

We are teaching kids this week that **sharing Jesus is God’s plan**. After Jesus died on a cross and rose again, He met two of His disciples walking on a road to a place called Emmaus. The disciples were talking about Jesus, but they did not realize He was the One walking with them! Jesus showed them that it was God’s plan to send a Savior to take the punishment for sin and to make the way for a relationship with Him. Jesus helped the disciples understand that God’s plan is to share Jesus with the world so all people can hear the truth.

**Highlight:** Luke 24:46-47

**Reflect:** What helps you recognize who Jesus is and what His plan is for His followers?

**Connect:** How can recognizing what Jesus has done in your life remind you that sharing Jesus is God’s plan?

## **Week 4 – May 24: Sharing Jesus Is Worth It**

## **Bible Story: The Farmer and the Seed (Matthew 13:1-23)**

We get to share a great story Jesus told, helping kids learn that **sharing Jesus is worth it**. In Matthew 13:1-23, Jesus told a story about a farmer who sowed seed on different types of soil. While not all the seed grew, those sown on good soil grew and multiplied. When we share Jesus, we are sowing “seed” like the farmer. We share about Him and do not know if people will listen and believe. But sharing Jesus is worth it because God *does* know, and He is the One who helps the “seed” of faith—grow!

**Highlight:** Matthew 13:23

**Reflect:** What can motivate you to share Jesus even when it is challenging or seems hopeless?

**Connect:** When do you think it is easy to share the good news of Jesus and when is it difficult?

## **Week 5 – May 31: Sharing Jesus Is Exciting**

## **Bible Story: The Holy Spirit and the Church (Acts 2)**

We have an exciting Bible story to share with kids this week! In Acts 2, God sent the Holy Spirit to fill the first Christians. Those people then shared Jesus with boldness in Jerusalem. God performed a miracle by helping the Christians share Jesus in different languages so everyone who listened could understand. That day, thousands of people believed and trusted in Jesus. Kids can know that sharing Jesus is exciting because God works to change lives and welcome people into His family.

**Highlight:** Acts 2:40-41

**Reflect:** The disciples in the early church witnessed amazing things which part do you think is the most exciting?

**Connect:** Have you shared Jesus with someone? If so, what happened?
